



GAI-TRONICS UK STATEMENT CONCERNING RoHS DIRECTIVE EU 2002/95/EC

It is GAI-Tronics UK view that all of our equipment currently placed on the market is intended to be operated as part of a fixed installation and is therefore excluded from the scope of the RoHS Directive.

GAI-Tronics products are intended to be installed by professional installers as part of an integrated system. Examples of such systems are Roadside and Trackside Telephone systems, Oil and Gas Evacuation systems and Public Access Emergency and Information Telephone systems.

Irrespective of the exclusion status claimed, GAI-Tronics are nevertheless committed to protecting human health and safeguarding the environment as is demonstrated by our certification to the Environmental Management System Standard ISO14001. We are voluntarily challenging our designers to use sustainable renewable resources in our products, introducing lead free soldering into manufacturing and using RoHS compliant components wherever possible.

GAI-Tronics is committed to ensuring that all of its products, where technically and economically feasible, are made fully compliant with the requirements of the RoHS Directive in the long term and considerable investment has been made in new equipment to facilitate this process.

We have almost completed the RoHS compliance programme for our full range of telephones. The majority of telephone units placed on the European market will be fully RoHS compliant by the end of July. The remainder, some of which are currently subject to design changes, will be fully compliant by the end of 2006. Individual product compliance statements will be available on request.
